OES offers a convenient and secure way for Ontario residents and businesses to recycle electronics free of charge.

This program was developed with Waste Diversion Ontario, on behalf of the Ontario government, under the Waste Diversion Act 2002. The program helps protect human health, our roadways, water ways and natural environments while creating a cleaner environmental future for Ontarians.

The OES program is regulated and meets rigorous standards. OES Service Providers must adhere to strict regulations and use a variety of techniques to ensure sensitive data is destroyed in the recycling process.
